Orientation:

Participants are staying at a hotel on the beach in La Jolla (see below), and the conference location is a 15-minute walk north along the beach at Scripps Institution of Oceanography, on the UC San Diego lower campus. La Jolla is a part of the city of San Diego, about 20 kilometers north of downtown. It is an upscale seaside resort. There are three parts of La Jolla: La Jolla Shores, where the hotel is located, the village of La Jolla, which is about two kilometers south of La Jolla Shores, and the main/upper campus of UC San Diego, which sits on high land above the coast.

Directions to Hotel:

The hotel is about 20 kilometers north of San Diego Airport (Lindbergh Field). Unless you're renting a car, you should take either a shuttle (shared van making several stops) or taxi from the airport to the hotel. A shuttle costs approximately \$25 and a taxi about \$50.

Conference Location (see map on next page):

The conference is at the [Scripps Seaside Forum](#), at Scripps Institution of Oceanography on the lower UC San Diego campus. This is an approximately 15-minute walk along the beach from the hotel.

Dress Code:

San Diegan participants at the Conference will vary in their dress from conventional business wear to business casual, depending on their preference and style. Business casual is acceptable for all events, but if you are usually a more formal dresser, that is fine.

Weather in June in San Diego:

Average daily maximum: 72.2 Fahrenheit/22.3 Celsius.

Average daily minimum: 62.6 Fahrenheit/17.0 Celsius.

Rainfall: June is a dry month, with an average total of 0.09 inches/0.2 cm.

Other: June is normally the cloudiest month of the year with only 57 percent of possible sunshine due largely to the persistence of overcast skies during the morning hours. This phenomenon is known locally as "[June Gloom](#)." Clear days average 9, partly cloudy 12 and cloudy 9. There is an average of one day of heavy fog.
