



Mary Lindenstein Walshok Ph.D. is Associate Vice Chancellor for Public Programs, Dean, University Extension, and Adjunct Professor of Sociology at the University of California, San Diego. Dr. Walshok is responsible for UCSD's outreach programs including executive education, continuing professional education, UCSD-TV, and a variety of community and economic development initiatives. She is responsible for a staff of 250 and annual revenues of over \$30 million. Dr. Walshok is a founder of the CONNECT program, which has played a prominent role in the creation and nurturing of high-tech clusters in San Diego since it was established in 1985. She is the author of two books, *Blue Collar Women* and *Knowledge Without Boundaries* (the latter dealing with the role of research universities in the economy), fifty published articles and book chapters, and numerous reports on the new economy and research capabilities for local and state agencies. Dr. Walshok holds a Visiting Professor position at the Stockholm School of Economics. She is the recipient of many awards, including most recently induction into Sweden's Royal Order of the Polar Star. Active in the arts and philanthropy, Walshok was the previous chairman of the \$400 million San Diego Community Foundation and remains active on their board.
